An **ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE RATES OF TAXATION** to be levied against personal and real property in Craighead County for the use and benefit of the cities, towns, schools and other entities in Craighead County for the tax year of 2021 to be collected in 2022.


ARTICLE 1. The tax rate to be levied on all taxable personal and real property in the County of Craighead for the use and benefit of the various cities, towns, schools, and other entities in Craighead County, Arkansas, for the tax year of 2021 to be collected in the year 2022 shall be as follows:



WHEREAS, Arkansas Code annotated 26-73-202 provides that the City Council of any Municipal corporation shall, on or before the time fixed by law for levying county taxes, make out and certify to the County Clerk the rate of taxation levied by said Municipal corporation on the real and personal property within such City or Town. The amount certified shall then be placed upon the tax books of the County Clerk of the County and collected in the same manner that State and County taxes are collected; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Bono, Arkansas, desiring to conform to the requirements of Arkansas Code Annotated 26-71-202, does hereby certify the rate of taxation to be as herein provided.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONO, ARKANSAS

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby certify and state that the rate of taxation to be levied by the City of Bono, Arkansas is as follows:

That this certification should be delivered by the Mayor of the City of Bono, Arkansas on or before the time fixed by law for levying county taxes to the County Clerk of Craighead County, Arkansas, so that the County Clerk may place the amount so certified on the tax books of the County Clerk and collect said taxes in the manner that the state and county taxes are collected.
