QUORUM COURT MINUTES NOVEMBER 13, 2023

Judge Day called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

Invocation was led by Spencer Furby, Valley View Church of Christ.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Justice Noel.

All Justices of the Peace were present.

The first order of business was approval of Quorum Court minutes from October 23, 2023. A motion to accept minutes as prepared was made by Justice Weinstock and seconded by Justice Pasmore. Judge Day took a vote and it passed unanimously.

The Road Committee report was read by Justice Cline. The Public Service Committee report was read by Justice Rogers and the Finance Committee report was read by Justice Longmire.

No OLD BUSINESS

Judge Day opened the floor for the next item on the agenda, discussion on the budget. Judge Day asked if everyone had received the budget sent Thursday. Justice Forrest asked if they were still going to make a comparison. Judge Day responds yes and asks if we want to start the discussions now or possibly meet next week and have a budget only meeting. Judge Day is open to suggestions from the court. Justice Cook agrees it would be better to have a meeting next week with a comparison. Judge Day agrees that we can do that, just want to get an idea what the court wants to do. Judge Day says they will get the comparison emailed out. Justice Barnes states he wants to review them both prior to the next meeting. Justice Cook reminded everyone that next week was Thanksgiving. Judge Day asked if next Monday is a problem for anyone, and further added that we could meet at the usual time with an agenda for just the budget review. Justice Barnes clarifies that we'll meet here, and Judge Day responds yes.

Justice Forrest has a question about the Resolution regarding the City of Brookland mills being zero. Judge Day responded.
